### **BILL SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis:

House Joint Memorial 11 proposes amending Article 4 of the New Mexico Constitution to establish a permanent Interim Oversight Administrative Rule Committee of 12 members of the state legislature. The committee may recommend to the legislature that agency rules be overturned, allowing the legislature to do so during a legislative session. The committee will meet at least once per month during the interim and will review proposed executive agency rules, provide recommendations to agencies, recommend statutory clarifications, and, if it determines that a rule does not comply with authorizing law, recommend that the Legislature overturn the rule during a legislative session. The proposed amendment, as set forth in this resolution, would be submitted to voters for approval or rejection at the next general election or a special election.
